5 Strategaeth CACC

5(i) Diwrnod Strategaeth

Adroddodd KC fod proses o ymgynghori wedi cymryd lle gyda staff proffesiynol a rheolwyr hŷn yn bresennol. Roedd cynrychiolwyr wedi cyfeirio at yr un hen broblemau – diffyg adnoddau, adeiladau a'r anallu i gyflawni gweithgareddau, ond teimlai'r Gadair bod angen edrych ymhellach na hyn. Fodd bynnag, roedd consensws fod archifau yn symud i'r cyfeiriad cywir.

Yn ystod trafodaethau agored mynegodd yr aelodau a oedd yn bresennol yn y Diwrnod Strategaeth y sylwadau canlynol: roedd y gwahanol grwpiau yn rhy fawr i gael trafodaeth rydd ac roedd rhai archifwyr yn gyndyn i fynegi barn oherwydd presenoldeb rheolwyr hŷn; nid oedd digon o amser i drafodaethau grŵp; byddai'r digwyddiad wedi bod yn well petai wedi ei gynnal dros ddau ddiwrnod a chydau mwy o grwpiau: cymysg oedd barn y rheolwyr hyn - teimlai un ein bod yn edrych unwaith eto ar bynciau a drafodwyd ddeng mlynedd yn ôl; roedd un arall yn ei weld fel cyfleoedd a gollwyd; tra roedd un arall yn bositif iawn.

5(ii) Strategaeth

Roedd y Gadair wedi adnabod nifer o themâu - fframwaith cenedlaethol, adnoddau, marchnata, datblygu adnoddau ar-lein, datblygu'r gweithlu, a chadwedigaeth ddigidol. Awgrymodd EJ fod angen maniffesto lefel uchel ar gyfer archifau yng Nghymru a dylid ei lunio cyn diwedd mis Mawrth. Roedd cyfarfod rhwng swyddogion CACC a CyMAL wedi trafod cais i CyMAL i gyllido ymgynghorydd i lunio maniffesto o'r fath. Gallai Linda Tomos wedyn ei gyflwyno i'r Gweinidog. Trafodwyd y cwestiwn pwy mewn gwirionedd oedd eisiau maniffesto - CACC neu CyMAL, gan fod gan CACC Polisi Archifau Cymru gan CACC yn barod. Byddai arlliw gwleidyddol ar faniffesto ac am y rheswm yma nid oedd KC yn hapus gyda'r gair 'maniffesto'. Nododd EJ mai proffil isel iawn oedd gan archifau yng ngolwg Llywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru o'i gymharu â'r ddau barth arall: byddai manifesto yn fodd i ddylanwadu ar wleidyddion ac yn gyfle i Linda Tomos sicrhau cyllid i CACC.

Cytunwyd i gyflwyno cynnig i CyMAL am gyllid i benodi ymgynghorydd i lunio strategaeth ar gyfer archifau yng Nghymru mor fuan ag sy'n bosibl.

6.1 Adroddiad y Gadair

Roedd KC wedi mynychu cyfarfod rhwng swyddogion CACC a CyMAL i drafod y ffordd ymlaen a sut y gallai'r ddau gorff gydweithio. Trafodwyd y pynciau canlynol: ceisiadau am nawdd y flwyddyn nesaf; y ffaith nad oedd swyddogion CACC yn gallu cyflawni dyletswyddau CACC a'r ffyrdd i oresgyn hyn; eiriolaeth; cyfathrebu; a phriodoldeb cyflwyno cais am nawdd i CyMAL i benodi ymgynghorydd i roi cymorth gyda'r math hyn o broblemau. Gorchwyl yr ymgynghorydd arfaethedig fyddai: cyfathrebu gydag aelodau ac yn allanol; codi proffil yn debyg i swydd ran-amser CILIP; a rheoli cynllun gweithredu a strategaeth. Roedd CyMAL yn fodlon cefnogi nifer cyfyngedig o swyddi am gyfnodau yn hwy na blwyddyn (hyd at dair blynedd) ond ni allai warantu cyllid dimond am y flwyddyn gyntaf yn unig.

Trafododd y swyddogion y Grŵp Rheoli Prosiect (GRhP) a'r modd y mae AC-AW yn cael ei redeg. Trafodwyd yr amod a roddodd CyMAL wrth dderbyn ceisiadau am grantiau 2007-08, sef fod y GRhP i gyfarfod bob mis; yr angen i'r GRhP gymryd rôl fwy strategol ac y dylai drosglwyddo rhai agweddau o waith dydd i ddydd y rhaglen i'r Rheolwr Rhaglenni. Cytunodd CyMAL y dylid anghofio am yr amod i gyfarfod yn fisol ac y dylai GRhP gymryd rôl fwy strategol.

Cytunwyd i drafod yr uchod yng nghyfarfod GRhP a oedd i'w gynnal yn y prynhawn.

Social Computing and Ask The People

Commissions completed and reports submitted

Social Computing – the report lacks rigour and does not deliver the required evidence base to take forward into a bid. Currently exploring options to obtain that evidence.

Pursuing quality issues concerning the report has taken up a disproportionate amount of both the Programme Manager's time and the PMG in a review cycle.

Ask The People – proposed some of her findings/personas at Strategy Day

Has incorporated feedback received there and from the PMG into her report. Report is currently under review; she has identified a number of willing strategic and delivery partners when it comes to defining specific projects.

Now need to tie the evidence to the funding body strategic priorities and pinpoint potential match funding. Looking at HLF Stage 1, JISC and EU FP7 bids this financial year. Require expertise in bid application and will be going to tender this month for this piece of work.

Inspiring Learning Through Archives

ILTA commission has commenced with Dr Lesley Walker conducting some preliminary research – she is very active and seems to have a wide and impressive range of contacts.

Developing the Vision

All archives and records offices in Wales have been visited by the Programme Manager, with one exception (visit to be arranged). Had meetings with NLW staff and have spoken at two SoA events. A collaborative space has been set up and all ARCW members now have access. Still have concerns about archivist community engagement – no take up of ArchifauCymru-ArchivesWales on Strategy Day, which was bitterly disappointing and little feedback from request for information about the collections. It is difficult to develop a vision if no-one is sharing it. Would like to explore ways of engaging with more junior staff, who may be more empathetic and enthusiastic to the technological aspects of the work. Met with HLF in Sept – main message seemed to be 'we don't fund websites and we won't consider another Linking Arms'. Visit to TNA – 10 people – good to see how Your Archives was working and to make contact with those actually operating the wiki – issues of moderation and language were discussed. Now have wiki capability for ANW – consulting with AJ on how to use this to elicit useful feedback on how ANW interface and functionality could be improved. Starting with bid writing next week – particularly for CyMAL grants which are likely to have an end-Jan deadline.

Catalog Cymru

Gareth has almost completed his report. Report will be anonymous – we agreed not to name specific offices, and I assume that this would extend to depositors. The confidentiality issue is more likely to apply to the database; FOI requests and sensitivity could be dealt with on a case-by-case basis?

Reach The People

AJ has been commissioned for the Audience Development Plan element of this work, which is planned for completion by end of this month; this is likely to slip. Likely to be an underspend in this area as we cannot proceed until the ADP is established. Will seek a Variance of Grant to redirect funds into other programme activity; we have notably failed to budget for translation.

ANW

Questionnaires are being drafted to send to the record offices of Anglesey, Conwy, and Pembroke to test the migration of data from ARCW to CALM since the replies to the original testing all concentrated on problems with CALM itself rather than the migration. A workflow for cataloguing new fonds level descriptions on both CALM and ANW will be drawn up by Nigel Callaghan to be circulated to all the partners once the testing has been completed and data has been migrated to all the partners.

Report on last SoA meeting

Strategy Day – I was not able to report to SoA on the day as promised, as results had not been made available by the facilitator at the time. Feedback from me and SoA members was unfortunately negative; it had been thought that more outcomes would result after such a big build-up: it was felt that the day was too general in nature; too much “blue sky thinking” and not enough concrete issues addressed; no ownership of issues was apparent; and it repeated what had gone before. Was it more basic in nature, because of managers attending? It was seen as a first step, though, and the meeting hoped that more will follow when results and an action plan become available.

SoA Website – Wales section

Has now been updated – more minutes, bilingual minutes and recent presentations are now available to view. In future meetings will also be put on the website.

Regional Officers’ meeting, Edinburgh

I attended this meeting which included talks on: the Society and MLA, post-spending review; Current position of the Sector; Leadership courses; Advocacy skills and experience in Scotland; Issues influencing archives communicating with Central Govt.

Changes in SoA budgeting were debated in the afternoon – expenses are to be voted on and to come from regional budgets in future. Concerns were expressed that this may disadvantage some regions as this includes travel costs. Jim Ranahan promises to address concerns and keep an eye on the situation with CfR officers’ help.

Joint meeting with the SouthWest Region

This was hosted in Gloucester recently by the SW Region. We enjoyed a tour of the office, and talks on Oral History Digitisation, Advising on Museums’ Archive holdings and Archives versus Museums Focus of Approach.

13th December – Llandrindod Wells – Advocating Archives

Is this a good opportunity to discuss the situation regarding advocacy in Wales, as many interested parties will be present? I need to report back to Peter Emmerson on the current situation and on future possibilities.

Next SoA meeting

This will be on 28th January at West Glamorgan. We hope to have a tour of and a talk about the new facilities, a visit by new SoA secretary John Chambers and a talk by Lesley Walker on ‘Inspiring Learning through Archives’
